Safety, Waiver, FAQs, and Parking

Please take time to look over the requirements. These rules will be strictly enforced as a Guinness World Records™ requirement. We want to ensure the safety of all attendees (four-legged and two-legged) during the event. For a detailed list of rules, [click here](#) to view the waiver. Please print out and **bring a signed copy of the waiver to the event!**

- 1. Participating dogs must be at least one (1) year old**
- 2. NO prong/shock/choke collars**
- 3. Only non-retractable leashes**
- 4. Leash must be under 8 feet long**

5. **No clothing/attire/bandannas etc. on your pet during the wedding (they CAN dress up after)**
6. **No pet body modifications (dyed hair, painted nails)**
7. **No female dogs in heat**
8. **An owner may supervise 2 dogs, any additional dogs must be accompanied by another person (13 years or older)**
9. **Dogs must be up to date on all vaccines**
10. **All COVID-19 guidelines per the CDC, IDPH and State of Illinois will be followed (masks are required)**
11. **Be responsible and keep your pet on leash at all times**

Want to save time in the check-in line? **Please bring proof of your dog's age** (such as a copy of their rabies certificate, birth certificate, or vet receipt). All dogs participating must be a year or older to qualify.
